- Accessible sites available
- Sites are rented on a first-come, first-served basis. Reservations are not accepted for the camping area.

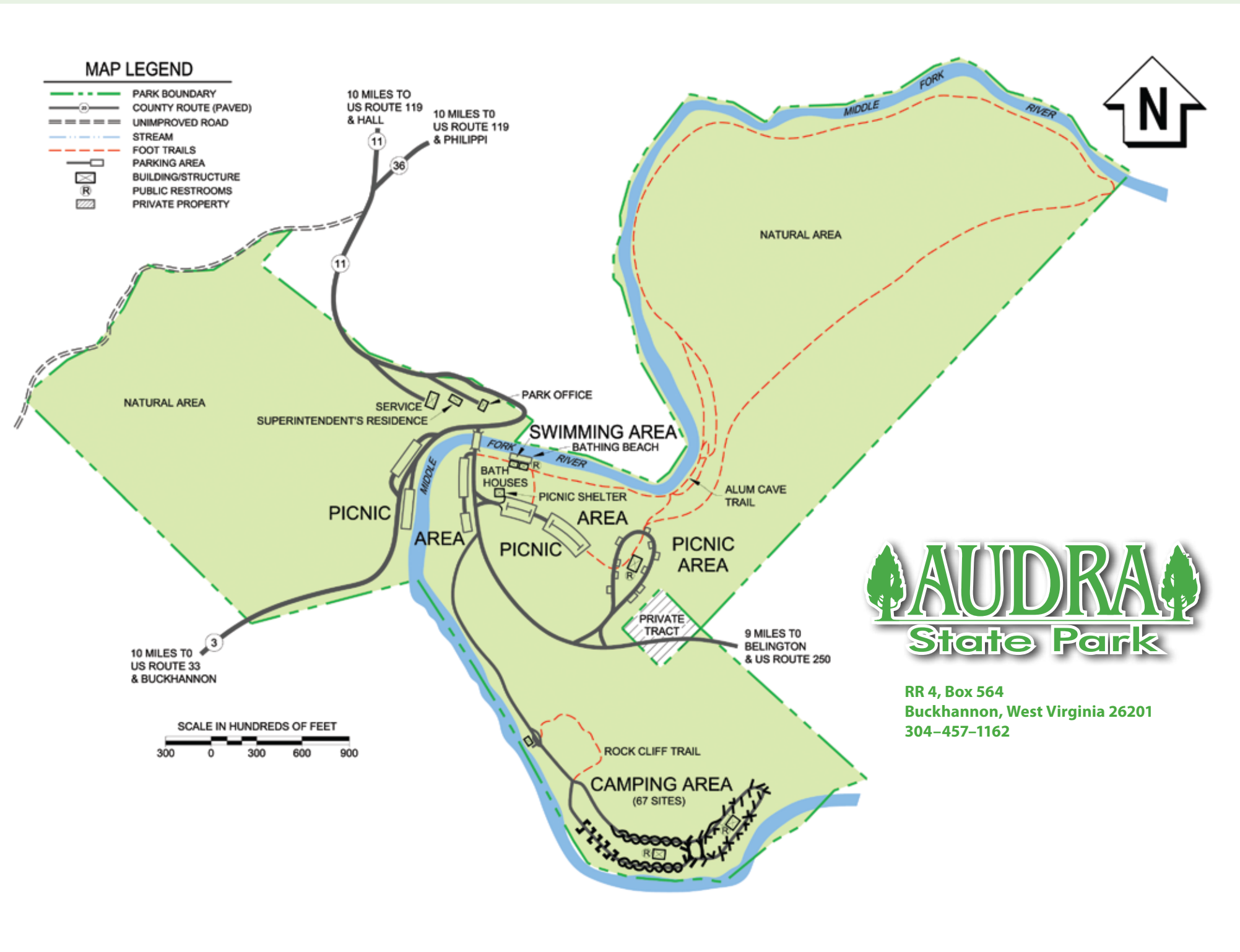

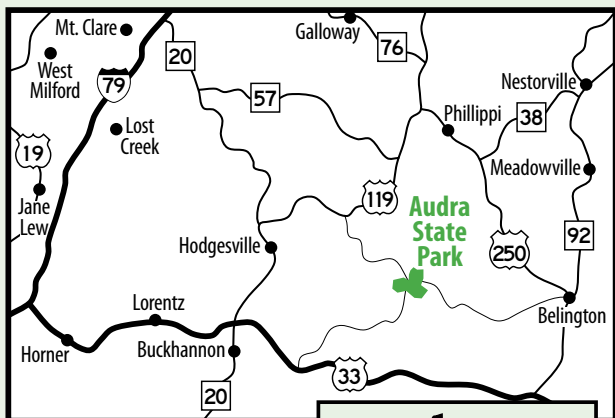

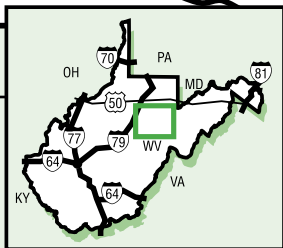
