Lodge and Cottages

Reservations may be made online, by writing or calling Twin Falls at (304) 294-4000 or by dialing toll free 1-800-CALL WVA and asking for Twin Falls Resort State Park. This toll-free line may be used in West Virginia or any other state in the continental U.S., and Canadian provinces in the Eastern time zone.

Twin Falls Lodge and cottages are open year-round. Advance reservations are recommended. Reservations—which can be made two years in advance—can be made online by visiting www.wvstateparks.com.

Cottages must be reserved for a minimum of one week (Monday to Monday) during the summer, beginning the second Monday in June through Labor Day. However, cottages may be rented by the day, two-day weekend or longer from Labor Day to the second Monday in June. Daily housekeeping service is not provided. Other rental options may be offered.

When making cottage reservations for four nights or more, a deposit fee is required with the remainder due upon arrival. The full rental fee is required for reservations of three nights or less. Lodge reservations require an advance deposit of the first night's rate. Reservation confirmations are mailed upon receipt of advance deposit payment.

Reservations made by telephone have 10 days in which to make payment unless it is a last minute reservation. Reservation payments may be secured by cash, personal check or credit card; guaranteed arrival by credit cards.

American Express, Diners Club, Discover, MasterCard and VISA are accepted.

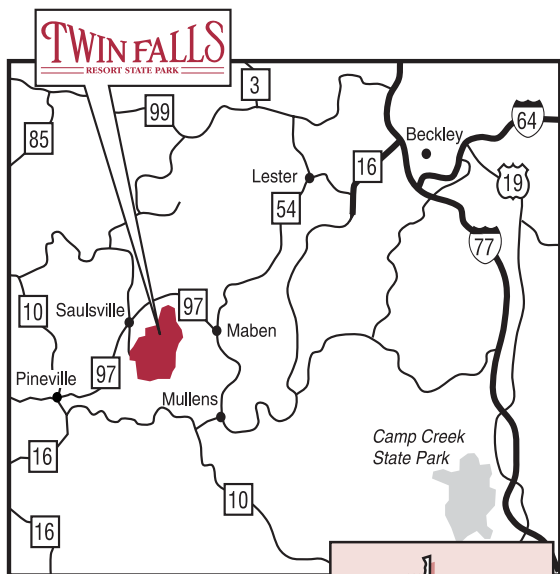
In case of cancellations, deposits will be returned (except for a \$20 handling fee for cottages) if notice is given at least 30 days in advance for cottages and 48 hours for lodge rooms.

Check-in time for lodge rooms is after 4:00 p.m., with check-out at 12 noon. Check-in time for cottages is guaranteed by 4:00 p.m. with check-out at 10:00 a.m.

Campground

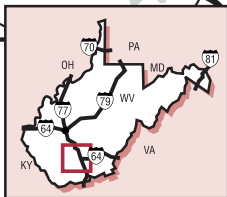
Twin Falls Campground is open year-round, with a maximum camping period of two weeks allowed. Reservations for a minimum of two nights are accepted for 50 percent of the campsites from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day. Only mail-in reservations will be accepted from mid-February to mid-March. Mail-in reservations must be postmarked on or after February 15, or they will be returned. A maximum of three reservation forms per envelope will be accepted. Beginning mid-March, phone reservations will be taken and filled subject to availability beginning April 1. Mail-in, call-in and walk-in reservations will be accepted from April through Labor Day Weekend.

If a reservation is canceled more than seven days in advance, the deposit will be refunded, with the exception of the handling fee plus the first night's rental. If canceled seven days or less, no refund will be given.



Location

Twin Falls is located southwest of Beckley, which is served by the major arteries, the West Virginia Turnpike (I-77) and I-64. Exit I-64/I-77 at Beckley, West Virginia, at Exit 42 (marked Beckley and Robert C. Byrd Drive). From Exit 42 it is 28 miles (45 minutes) to Twin Falls Lodge. Turn right onto state Route 16 South/state Route 97 West (marked Sophia, Mullens). Drive approximately 3.5 miles on Route 16 South/Route 97 West. This is a four-lane road. Bear right onto state Route 54 South toward Mullens. Drive approximately 15 miles on state Route 54 South. You will drive through the towns of Glen White and Lester. Please observe posted speed limits. At Maben, turn right onto state Route 97 West. Drive 5.5 miles on state Route 97 West. At stop sign turn left onto Bear Hole Road. It is 4.1 miles to Twin Falls Lodge.
