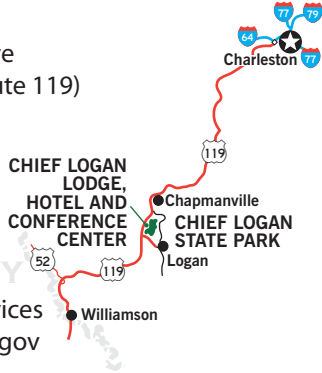

- Restaurant
 - Full-service, year-round
 - Seating capacity: 90
- Private Dining Room
 - 16' x 19' — within restaurant
 - Seating capacity: 20
- Cardinal Room
 - 15' x 26'
 - For private lunch or dinner meetings
 - Seating capacity: 18
- Sessions Lounge
 - Open for groups as contracted; serves restaurant daily

GUEST AMENITIES
